- Federal Rescheduling hearings underway in late January
- Attorneys make oral arguments in the Cannaprovisions case, challenging federal prohibition
- With a nationwide injunction, CTA compliance is on hold, but the 1/1/25 reporting deadline may be revived
- IRS warns cannabis companies about the improper use of disclosure Form 8275 for refund claims and “no-280E” return positions
- A proposed federal bill would redefine hemp. Texas pursues a ban on all consumable hemp products
- Kentucky approves first medical use licenses and Florida increases MMTC licenses, other states update their cannabis policies
